d. Summer School

The anticipated cost for summer school programs is \$12,000. Currently there is \$5,000 in the FY 2017/18 budget. James Purdon made a motion to authorize an additional allocation of \$7,000 for summer school. The motion was seconded by David Gaudreau and passed unanimously.

e. <u>Tuition for Out-of-District Students</u>

James Purdon made a motion to increase regular education tuition to \$11,477 in 2017/18 and \$11,741 in 2018/19. The motion was seconded by Edward Perron and passed unanimously.

f. Approval of Job Descriptions for Team Leaders and Faculty Coordinators

A draft job description for Team Leaders and Faculty Coordinators were distributed. The
Board will be asked to take action on them in June.
