FY 2022/2023 Budget Workshop

Superintendent Sullivan presented the proposed district budget for 2022-2023 to the Board of Education members. The building principals presented budget highlights for their respective school, and the student services director provided an overview of budget drivers for special education. The proposed budget of \$19,462,163 represents an increase of \$498,756 or a 2.63% increase over the current year.

The Board decided to form a sub-committee to review additional information and may elect to communicate with the Board of Finance and/or the Board of Selectmen on behalf of the Board of Education.

Christopher Steinbrick made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by James Purdon and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:51 P.M.
