- Early Childhood screenings help the Putnam Public Schools work with families to support each child's development.

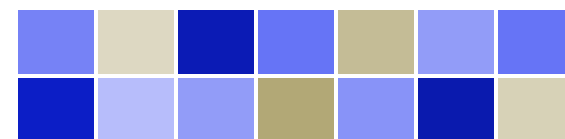

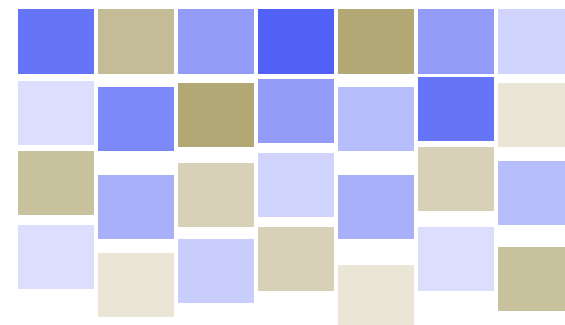

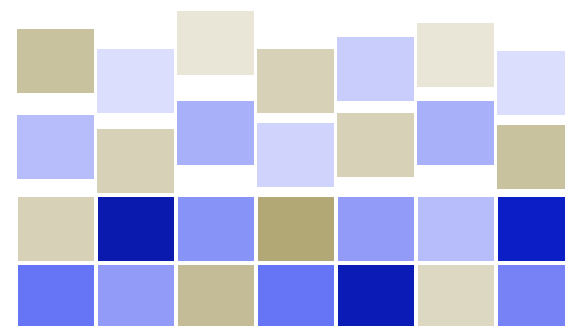

## WHAT IS AN EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING?

A free check of your child's development  
in the areas of:

### *Fine and Gross Motor Skills:*

- Jumping
- Balancing
- Drawing/Writing

### *Speech and Language Development:*



- Using words
- Producing Sounds
- Following directions

### *Social Skills:*

- Playing
- Taking Turns
- Getting along with others

### *Thinking and Learning:*

- Solving Problems
- Counting
- Sustaining attention during activities



## WHO SHOULD BE SCREENED?



All children between the ages of 2.9 years  
(33 months) through kindergarten entry are  
invited to attend a screening.

## WHY SCREEN?

An early childhood screening begins a  
home-school partnership that supports life-  
long learning. At a screening, families and  
school staff begin the process of working  
together on behalf of each child.

## WHAT HAPPENS AT THE SCREENING?



Families will have an opportunity to  
meet school staff and other families, learn  
about our early childhood programs, and  
observe various screening activities.



## WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE SCREENING?

You will receive a letter describing  
the screening outcome and  
suggested activities for you to enjoy  
with your child.

Other recommendations may  
include a follow-up screening or  
services at school. All screening  
information is confidential and is  
kept in your child's school records  
to measure progress.
