## Guidance Department Chairperson:

For the 44<sup>st</sup> consecutive year we are offering financial help to qualified Connecticut high school seniors who are interested in a career in education. We want to thank you for all the wonderful candidates you have sent us in the past. Please post the enclosed flier and encourage all possible applicants to apply. Information about our scholarship is listed below as well as on the ARTC web site [www.artct.org](http://www.artct.org) with the application which applicants can download, and directions for mailing. 2023 graduates of secondary schools in Connecticut are eligible to apply, **IF they are committed to pursuing a career in the field of education**. Our criteria are as follows:

- **Personal and educational qualifications**
  - **Academic record**... transcript of grades from Grade 9 through first semester of Grade 12 plus SAT scores, GPA and class rank, if available
  - **Character and Personality**... as presented in two letters of recommendation and other sections of the application (i.e. volunteer activities, etc.)
  - **Interests and Educational Activities**... as expressed in applicant's essay and other sections of the application
- **Financial Need** to be determined by the Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA

**Scholarships** to be awarded are **one** four-year scholarship of \$2000 for 4 years (The winner must maintain college grades in the upper bracket and must continue teacher preparation training.) **PLUS two** 1-year scholarships of \$2000 (for freshmen).

**Submission...** Students MUST use the 2023 online application and directions for mailing found at [www.artct.org](http://www.artct.org). Each year there are changes to the application form; application forms from previous years will not be accepted. On the banner, the Glenn Moon Scholarship is listed. Please read and click on the "CLICK HERE TO CONTINUE TO THE DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION." The application is available **ONLY** on line. Your students will create an on-line folder to mail to one of our readers on the committee.

Under "Submission Directions," please click to find your town. Then find your high school in that town. In the last columns (on the right) you will find the name and email address of the Board Member for your area that accepts your application. Email your completed application folder to the **Board Member in your area by March 31, 2023.**

**Do NOT** send your application to the [glennmoon.scholarship@gmail.com](mailto:glennmoon.scholarship@gmail.com) or ARTC address. Again, your students are **creating an on-line folder** with all parts required.

Transcripts and letters of rec. that cannot be included by the students, should be sent as attachments to the correct reader/board member (to be found on the web site) with the student's name as the header and a note of explanation **and must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2023.**

**Winners** will be notified by telephone and a confirming letter early in May 2023. The winners will also be announced at [www.artct.org](http://www.artct.org) website.
