- High School Seniors Need:
 - A copy of an acceptance letter or provisional acceptance letter from the college the applicant hopes to attend.
 - A high school transcript copy (unofficial).
 - Current photograph of yourself

The application deadline is May 12, 2023. Only applications received on or before that deadline are considered. Applications will not be returned. Recipients will be notified by June 30, 2023.
