Herbert C. Arico Scholarship Application

I wish to participate in the essay contest for an opportunity to win one of two \$1000 Herbert C. Arico Scholarships awarded by Northeast Family Federal Credit Union.

The Scholarship is named for Herbert C. Arico who taught at Windham High School for 58 years and has served on the Northeast Family Credit Union's Board of Directors since 1964 when he joined the Board of East Central Connecticut Teachers' Credit Union. Herb continues his commitment to education as a member of the Willington Board of Education, a member of the Region 19 Board of Education, and of the EastCONN Board of Directors. Northeast Family Credit Union began in 1938 to serve educators and is proud to promote education in that tradition with the Herbert C. Arico Scholarship.

I understand that I must meet the following eligibility requirements, not have won previously and supply the following in order to qualify for this scholarship:

- 1. Be a high school graduate in 2023 (or before) and have at least a 2.5 grade point average. (Verification from your high school is to be enclosed.)
- 2. Be enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical school in the fall of 2023. (Proof of enrollment is to be provided prior to disbursement of the \$1000).
- 3. Be a member at Northeast Family Federal Credit Union.
- 4. Submit an essay. The essay can be in written form (no more than 500 words) or a YouTube video, not longer than two minutes and should answer one of the following questions:
- 1. What is an issue that is currently affecting your community? What can YOU do to help?
- 2. Sometimes we face some things in life that are difficult. Write about a time you faced a situation that was difficult for you, and how you got through it to triumph over the adversity.
- 3. Write about a teacher that changed your life. This doesn't necessarily need to be a teacher you encountered in school! What life lessons did they teach you, and how are you a better person today as a result of them?
 - 5. Be available to accept a scholarship check, if chosen, at the Annual Meeting, May 31st, 2023.
 - 6. Application, essay and accompanying documentation should arrive no later than **May 12**th, **2023** and sent to:
