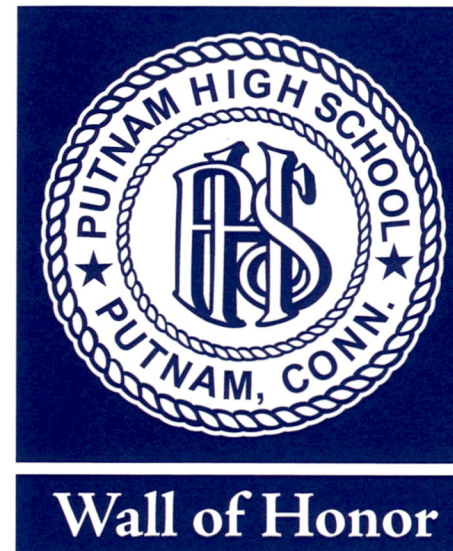

Robert Miller, 1938

Miller served on several town and city committees including Board of Selectmen, but is probably best remembered for his knowledge and promotion of the history of Putnam, especially the town's historical mills. This led to being named First Town Historian. Lifelong affiliation with Boy Scouts of America spanned thirty-three years leading to receiving the highest award in scouting for accomplishments and service. The Putnam River Trail has been dedicated in his honor.



Jonathan Gradie, 1969

As a space-related scientist, educator and entrepreneur, Gradie has been directly involved in the creation and growth of three high tech start-up companies. His astronomy contributions in observing solar system objects led to recognition by the International Astronomical Union naming an asteroid after him, No.3253 Gradie. Served on several NASA Earth Observation teams. He was also an Ernst and Young Entrepreneur of the Year award finalist in 2000.



Peter Deary, 1973

Deary used his business management degree as a springboard to a forty-two year career managing and eventually owning seventeen Sunnyside Farms, Inc. stores throughout the region. He still found time to establish a long history of serving on several community organizations and various fund-raising causes which earned him the "Civic Achievement Award" from the Northeast Chamber of Commerce for a lifetime of dedicated service.



Laura Phipps, 1976

Phipps made an early decision to pursue a career as Physician's Assistant leading to a focus on women's health and child sexual abuse victims. As a forensic medical examiner she was instrumental in developing the medical trauma program at "Kid's House" in Seminole, FL. Extensive involvement in Rotary International led to the establishment of the "Laura Phipps Legacy Award" presented annually by the Rotary Club of Altamonte Springs, FL.



Shawn Johnston, 1977

Johnston lost his father when he was six years old but was blessed by a community that provided much support. That debt has been paid back ten fold with his ongoing involvement in the Putnam area. Served as an independent "voice of reason" as State Representative for sixteen years, while still donating time and energy to several Boards. Along with family members and friends, started the Thanksgiving Day Turkey Dip which has raised several hundred thousand dollars for Muscular Dystrophy.
